

Job Description: Mental Health Clinician - Associate

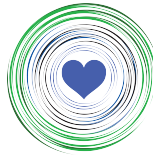
Welcome to our group practice! We are looking for pre-licensed (associate) clinicians to join our group practice as a 'full-time' employee.
